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General Information & Vendor Contract

Mission Statement

The Farmers Market at SEC is on a mission to provide a space that will connect the residents of our city with local farmers, producers and artisans in a clean, friendly and community-oriented environment.

Vendors' Products

Market vendors are expected to follow all applicable health regulations as set out by the Province of Manitoba. Vendor information will be forwarded to the market's health inspector as needed. Please make sure to have ALL permits on your person at a market in the event of an inspection.

Market Rules

1. Vendors are expected to abide by our Mission Statement as written above and follow the rules as written below.
2. The Farmers Market will run from 4 -7pm every Tuesday from June 16 - September 29, 2026. You should be at your stall and ready to sell within 20 mins of the opening of market. There will be no driving within the market from 3:40 pm till end of market.
3. As a courtesy to other participants at the market, we ask that you conduct your business within your stall's boundaries only.
4. Canopies enhance the visibility of the market, protect your products, and create a sales area for your goods. All vendors should have their own canopy but is not required to take part. Please note we **do not** provide canopies to vendors.
5. Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables, chairs, canopy weights (this is NOT an option if you have a canopy, you MUST have it adequately weighed down), and any display equipment. These items cannot remain onsite and must be removed from the grounds at the end of each market day.
6. Vendors must have obtained their own permits/licenses for selling their products as required by the Province of Manitoba.
7. As a courtesy to your neighbouring vendors, all vendors are expected to remain at the market for the full duration.
8. Smoking / Vaping & Alcohol Consumption is **NOT** permitted within the market area
9. For everyone's safety and comfort, vendors are **not** permitted to bring their pets (unless a service animal).
10. Prices for products must be clearly displayed for customers to see.



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11. Vendors are responsible for cleaning their stalls at the end of the day. All garbage and recyclables should be removed from stall areas and disposed of in the proper receptacles.
12. Washroom facilities are available inside the Event Centre.
13. New vendors can request stalls up to one week before a market date.
14. Vendors selling products by weight must use approved scales bearing the stamp of Canada Weights and Measures.
15. No verbal or physical abuse toward visitors, coordinators, or fellow vendors will be tolerated.
16. Personal belongings are the responsibility of the vendor and not the responsibility of the Event Centre.
17. The Event Centre reserves the right to cancel or close the market due to unforeseen weather or circumstances beyond our control. We will do our best to move the market inside, if at all possible. If we do need to close or cancel the market, the Event Centre coordinator will give as much notice as possible.
18. Vendor children must be supervised at all times during market hours.

Enforcement of Rules

We assume that all parties participating in the market are eager and willing to take part in a mutually successful and enjoyable venture. If any of the above rules are violated, the coordinator will do their best to resolve the issue(s) by talking with the party (parties) involved. If a party continues to violate any rule, a letter of warning will be sent to that party. A letter of warning will be kept on file for 24 months. If a vendor receives 3 letters of warning within a 24-month period, they will no longer be allowed to participate in the market.

Fees & Payments

Once we have processed this form and if you have been approved, you will receive an invoice. Payment must be made within 7 days of receiving the invoice, if there is less than 7 days before your market date, then payment must be made prior to your market date. Spots will be secured after payment is received.

Stall rentals are \$30 per date, per stall + GST

Complete season paid in full at the beginning of the season is \$450 + GST

Refunds will be issued at the discretion of the Event Centre coordinator and will be subject to a \$15 administration fee.



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Terms of Service

I understand that I, the exhibitor, am responsible for any loss, damage, or injury related to my display, equipment, or property while participating in the event.

I agree that the Farmers Market, Southeast Event Centre, and its team members, employees, and volunteers are not responsible for any claims or costs related to my participation, except in cases of their negligence.

I also understand that it is my responsibility to obtain any insurance for my property or potential loss of revenue, and that I am fully responsible for my own liabilities.
